In the meantime Hazel has handed over her membership to Sandie Mathers.

Next meeting

Results so far

A timetable (see attachment) and internet forum were set up to structure and facilitate the discussions. On this forum draft documents are placed for discussion like organisation models and a constitution. However it takes some time to get used to work with such a digital forum it is very efficient to have all information available in one place. For a real face-to-face discussion the group will meet in Munich the last weekend of March.

Items to be discussed in Munich

Organisation model

The group designs the intended European Association of Radiographers as a *federation* of national societies, without individual membership. The way this federation can be linked to ISRRT needs further discussion. In consultation with ISRRT several possibilities will be worked out and presented in the European meeting in November.

Constitution

The development of a draft constitution is well on its way. In the Rome meeting it was decided that membership of the new structure would be open to all European countries. In the minutes of the Brighton meeting however it is stated that it should be EU/EEA and Switzerland. The working group prefers to stick to the first decision, but this item will be on the agenda again in November.

Financial plan

This plan will be drafted in the coming weeks.

What can you aspect

In accordance with our timetable we will distribute a draft proposal (organisation and finances) for comments to all European Societies and council members by the 15th of April.
